To promote the building of "Social Capital", HKQAA has developed a Project on "Bridging and Bonding - To Create Measurable Social Benefits", funded by the Community Investment and Inclusion Fund (CIIF). It aims to promote the adoption of the Corporate Social Capital (CSC) concepts and norms by the Hong Kong corporations with a view to bringing about mutual benefits to both the corporations and the society, recognizing that this is an essential part of a corporation's social responsibility.

In this seminar, we will present our first work in this funding project – the **Draft Corporate Social Capital Implementation Guidance Document 1 (DGD1)** which will be put forward for trial implementation by our collaborating corporations for preparing the final Guidance Document (GD). The DGD1 was developed with reference to local and international research papers, such as those released by the **World Bank** and **CIIF** in recent years.

In addition to the development of a useful GD, other funded activities include a series of training workshops, a web-based stakeholders platform, the personnel and project registration schemes to facilitate the application of the GD.
