(9 November 2018, Hong Kong) Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency (HKQAA) today held the “HKQAA Networking Cocktail Reception 2018 for Wine Industry” at the Hong Kong International Wine & Spirits Fair.

Third-party recognition enhances confidence in wine-related business

The zero-tax environment and well-developed transportation facilities have made Hong Kong one of the most cost-effective and convenient wine hubs in the Asia Pacific region. In response to market needs, HKQAA launched the Wine Storage Management Systems Certification Scheme in 2009 to promote the protection of wine quality and value through systematic storage management. In 2013, HKQAA took a further step and rolled out the Hong Kong Wine Registration Scheme to help companies demonstrate their commitment to providing wines with an identifiable source.

“Wine lovers now look into the source, storage and transportation conditions of wines, besides brands and vintages. There is no doubt that third-party recognition plays a substantial role in giving consumers, collectors and traders confidence in Hong Kong’s wine-related businesses.” said Dr Ir Hon. Lo Wai Kwok, SBS, MH, JP, chairman of the HKQAA.

Joining hands to foster wine business development

HKQAA has also joined hands with the industry to enhance wine business development in the region. Last year, funded by The Organisation Support Programme under the Dedicated Fund on Branding, Upgrading and Domestic Sales, HKQAA supported the Hong Kong Wine Chamber of Commerce to implement “To Promote Brand of Hong Kong Wine Industry to Become the First Choice of Procurement in the Mainland Market Project 2017-2018”. The project aimed to strengthen the brand of Hong Kong in the region and improve the industry.

In today’s event, Mr Henry Ho, the President of Hong Kong Wine Chamber of Commerce gave an overview of the Project. New participants in the Wine Storage Management Systems Certification Scheme also shared their good practices in wine storage management. The event received positive responses from wine professionals and the industry.
