## HKQAA invited to share on MiC Supply Chain Conference in Huizhou

The Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) Supply Chain Conference, co-organised by the Development Bureau of the HKSAR Government, the Department of Housing and Urban-Rural Development of Guangdong Province and the People's Government of Huizhou Municipality, was held in Huizhou on 23 January 2024, attracting some 300 participants from the construction sector in Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao.
