HKQAA Honorary Chairman passes away

It is with great sadness that we announce that Dr T. L. Ng, SBS, JP (伍達倫博 \pm , SBS, \pm , 太平紳士), Honorary Chairman of the Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency, passed away on 14 January 2013.

Dr Ng worked in the industrial sector for over forty years and held many prominent public service positions, including Honorary Chairman of our Agency, Chairman of the Employee Retraining Board, Chairman of the Occupational Safety and Health Council, Chairman of the Hong Kong Automotive Parts and Accessory Systems R&D Centre, Deputy Chairman of the Council of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Deputy Chairman of the Council of the VTC and Vice Chairman of the Applied Research Council. He made significant contributions to the industrial development of Hong Kong and was actively involved in serving the community. In recognition of his dedication, he was awarded the Bronze Bauhinia Star (BBS) and Silver Bauhinia Star (SBS) in 2002 and 2011 respectively.

Dr Ng was one of the founding members of the Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency and so played an important role in the promotion of management systems and improving competitiveness of businesses. He was our Chairman from 1999 to 2007 and was influential in making the Agency what it is today, a leading conformity body in Hong Kong and the region.

Our Agency will always cherish Dr Ng's valuable contributions and remember him with great affection and respect. We would like to take this opportunity to express our deepest condolences to his family.
