

Conversion Arrangement for TL 9000 Measurements Handbook Release 5.6

Telecommunications Industry Association - Business Performance Community (TIA-BPC, previously named as QuEST Forum) has officially published the TL 9000 Measurements Handbook Release 5.6 Point Release with effective 30 June 2019. The details of changes are listed out in the TL 9000 website:

According to TIA-BPC's requirements, organisation may submit measurements data using the Release 5.6 rules starting with July 2019 data and must use the Release 5.6 rules starting with December 2019 data. Moreover, at a minimum, all changes between Release 5.5 and Release 5.6 which impact the organisation must be assessed during the conversion audit of the organisation, including the data submission using the rules of the new release of the handbook (R5.6) in order to become certified to the Measurements Handbook Release 5.6.

We will endeavor to assist you to ensure a smooth transition to meet the requirements of the new Measurements Handbook.
