The role of international and industry standards to facilitate Modular Integrated Construction (MiC)

INTRODUCTION

The use of prefabricated components in the construction sector is not a new phenomenon, and has been employed quite extensively over the years for elements such as facades, walls, bathrooms and others. By comparison, Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) is a relatively new and innovative construction method by which an entire building is substantially completed off-site. This can lead to significant improvements in productivity, quality, environmental impact, site safety and project management/scheduling, by reducing the number of onsite construction processes and replacing them by offsite activities that can be carried out under more controlled and consistent conditions.

Typical elements include free-standing integrated modules (complete with finishes, fixtures and fittings) that are manufactured in a factory, transported to the construction site and then installed to form a building



HOW CAN STANDARDS HELP?

There are a number of ways in which International and industry standards can help to facilitate MiC, and conversely, ways in which MiC makes it easier to comply with standards and building regulations

Quality management: The core standard that is relevant to all industry sectors is of course the well-established ISO 9001, which specifies a series of requirements for an organization to demonstrate its ability to "consistently provide products and services that meet customer and applicable statutory and regulatory requirements". Whilst ISO 9001 has been implemented extensively throughout the Hong Kong Construction Sector, the use of MiC can bring about radical changes in the level of consistency that can be achieved in a factory environment compared to that on a construction site, the latter inevitably being a less controlled environment, subject to the weather and other external conditions. A factory setting also lends itself more readily to the application of quality methodologies such as Statistical Process Control (SPC), "Lean Six-sigma" and 5S, to name but a few. That is not to say that these cannot be implemented on a construction site, but the more controlled environment of a factory represents a quantum shift in the levels of consistency that can be achieved.



Environmental management: There is of course increasing global awareness and concern about the environment, particularly in the construction sector. Although ISO 14001 is the core standard for environmental management, and many HK companies in the construction sector have successfully achieved ISO 14001 certification, other factors are now also coming into play, such as Energy Management (ISO 50001), Business Continuity Management (ISO 22301) for which factory settings are much less likely to be affected by typhoons, for example, than a construction site, and more recent initiatives like the "SDG Management System" standard that is currently in the early stages of development by ISO (tentatively to be published as ISO 53001). Within the policy and regulatory context the EU's "Green Deal" aims to achieve climate neutrality by 2050 through a plan expected to start delivering results from 2030. In the construction field, environmental impact targets pay special attention to the "use" phase and integrating the manufacture of products and construction activities under each country's more general industrial strategy. Building Regulations globally are also increasingly incorporating environmental and energy efficiency requirements for which MiC can make a positive contribution, In Europe, these include the EU's Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) as well as recent changes being incorporated into the EN "Eurocode" standards for building design.

Health and Safety Management: It goes without saying that health and safety has to be an important consideration for any construction project. ISO 45001 (formerly OHSAS 18001) forms the basis for certification, providing confidence in an organization's ability to provide a heathy and safe working environment. This is more readily implemented in the controlled conditions of a factory environment, where health and safety risks can usually be more easily identified and mitigated than on a construction site.

Product Certification: MiC does not of course eliminate all construction site activities, and product certification schemes such as the Quality Scheme for the Production and Supply of Concrete (QSPSC) continue to provide additional confidence, in addition to those activities that are conducted off-site. QSPSC consists of two parts (Administrative Regulations and Technical Regulations) and requires suppliers to operate in accordance with ISO 9001 as a core quality component as well as having concrete samples subjected to testing by accredited laboratories.

Digitalization: Traceability and the development of traditional "as-built" drawings and schematics has always been a difficult undertaking, but in recent years it has benefited from digitalization initiatives, underpinned by numerous international standards, most notably ISO/IEC 27001 for Information Security Management. In this context, Building Information Modelling (BIM) is a key factor in ensuring the success of MiC initiatives. It gives architects, engineers and construction professionals the ability to plan, design and manage building projects more efficiently by the sharing of reliable information at all stages of a project. In this respect, the ISO 19650 series of standards ("Organization and digitization of information about buildings and civil engineering works, including building information modelling (BIM) — Information management using building information modelling") can be particularly useful. The series currently comprises 5 parts, as follows:

- Part 1: Concepts and principles
- Part 2: Delivery phase
- Part 3: Operational phase
- Part 4: Information exchange
- Part 5: Security-minded approach to information management

Figure 1 shows how, once again, ISO 9001 is a core building block for organizational management, as well as standards such as ISO 21500 (for overall Project Management during the delivery phase) and ISO 55000 (for Asset Management during the operational phase of the building)

CONCLUSIONS

Modular Integrated Construction (MiC) offers new and exciting opportunities for Hong Kong's construction industry to rise to the global challenges of improved quality, productivity, and sustainability that are increasingly being demanded by policymakers, regulators and citizens/consumers. There is a symbiotic relationship between the use of international and industry standards to facilitate the implementation of MiC and the use of MiC to facilitate the implementation of such standards to meet policy and regulatory requirements.

Political and business leaders from the Greater Bay Area (GBA) explore livable city strategies

The sustainable development of cities has emerged as a vital concern. As one of the pioneers in fostering sustainability in the GBA, HKQAA invited renowned leaders and experts from the GBA to share their insights into this important topic at the Symposium. The aim is to support the United Nations and the Government in addressing climate change and promoting green and sustainable development.

The Shenzhen Administration for Market Regulation served as the collaborating organisation for the event. Expert speakers included Mr Ryan Ip, CFA, MRICS, Vice President and Co-Head of Research of Our Hong Kong Foundation; Ms Zhou Quan, Member of the 14th National Committee of the CPPCC, Deputy Chief Engineer of Guangdong Provincial Academy of Building Research; Mr Ng Wang Tsang, Andy, Chairman of Hong Kong General Chamber of Social Enterprises; Ir Dr Cary Chan, JP, Executive Director of Hong Kong Green Building Council; Ir Allan Chan, MH, Permanent Supervisor of Hong Kong Construction Association; and Professor Thomas Ng, Head of the Department of Architecture and Civil Engineering, City University of Hong Kong.

New services promote the application of innovative construction methods

As one of the leading conformity assessment bodies and standard setters in the GBA, HKQAA organises industry exchange activities and has taken the lead in developing a range of services in green and sustainable finance, carbon neutrality, climate risk management and ESG disclosure. The Agency is dedicated to actively participating in the development of national, international and industry standards and committed to promoting sustainable development within the industry. Furthermore, HKQAA collaborates with organisations such as Shenzhen Administration for Market Regulation in an alliance to carry out product carbon footprint labelling certification in the GBA, promoting low-carbon economic development in the region.

Ir C.S. Ho, Chairman of HKQAA, said, "We support the construction industry in addressing challenges and trends by developing new initiatives and services for promoting the adoption of Modular Integrated Construction (MiC), Building Information Modeling (BIM), and the Common Data Environment (CDE). These aim to drive improvements in efficiency and sustainability performance by promoting the adoption of innovative construction methods."

Mr Tai Sheung Shing, Victor, JP, Acting Secretary for Housing of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, emphasised the importance of new technologies in housing construction in his opening remarks. He stated that it is essential to adopt new technologies to construct a substantial number of houses in a short period while maintaining high quality. In recent years, architectural design has extensively utilised BIM, MiC and architectural robotics technology. These new technologies can help build houses with higher quantity, speed, and efficiency. This direction of development is very clear and widely recognised by the industry.

He also mentioned that HKQAA has been providing various certifications and professional services in this regard. These include certifications related to BIM, different services related to MiC and CDE, as well as the Net-zero Certificate Scheme. All of these offerings support the construction industry in building sustainable and high-quality housing. He expressed his gratitude to HKQAA for its continuous support of Government policies, providing professional certification and assessment services, aligning with government strategies, and supporting the latest developments in various aspects, promoting the industry's advancement, and benefiting society.

Symposium's contribution to inclusive and sustainable development

The Symposium was live streamed throughout the day, attracting an online and offline audience of over 800 senior executives from Government departments, professional organisations, academic institutions and businesses in the GBA.

Ir Ho said, "It is hoped that the event can draw upon our collective wisdom to explore forward-looking strategies on topics such as innovative construction methods, green and low-carbon initiatives and inclusive communities, to accelerate the sustainable development of cities in the GBA."

The Hong Kong Maritime Museum was chosen to be the event venue since it is a good example of an inclusive and sustainable community. It promotes historical and cultural heritage, as well as social inclusivity though a social enterprise collaboration project called Café 8, which supplied refreshments for the Symposium. The Café provides employment opportunities for individuals with learning disabilities.

Recognising organisations and companies that contribute to green and sustainable development

A presentation ceremony for the "Green and Sustainability Contribution Awards 2023" was held at the Symposium. The Awards aim to encourage companies to incorporate sustainable practices into their management decisions and daily operations, and recognise their efforts and contributions. This year, 400 companies and venues from Hong Kong and other cities in the GBA were honoured. For details, please refer to the awardee list in the appendix.

Dr Michael P. H. Lam, Chief Executive Officer of HKQAA, said that he expected these organisations to play a leading role in encouraging more industry members to put sustainable development concepts into practice. HKQAA will continue to collaborate closely with all sectors of society to jointly build a sustainable future.

HKQAA's Green and Sustainable Finance Certification Scheme: Selected as an Excellent Case by SAMR

The Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency's (HKQAA)Green and Sustainable Finance Certification Scheme has been selected by China's State Administration for Market Regulation (SAMR) as an "excellent" example of "Special and Sophisticated" International Collaboration on Mutual Recognition of Quality Certification.

It is a great honour that HKQAA's Scheme was selected as one of the outstanding cases, especially since this is the first evaluation programme of its kind organised by SAMR. The result was announced on September 6, 2023 at the Forum on Conformity Assessment Serving Trade Facilitation in China.

The programme aims to promote the achievements of international collaboration on mutual recognition of quality certification. It seeks to facilitate domestic and international economic flows, promote openness, cooperation and trade facilitation, and provide a set of successful models that can be replicated when building new systems for a higher-level open economy.

It is a major move for SAMR to advance international collaboration on quality certification of broader scope, higher standards and greater depth.

Green and sustainable finance serves as a strategic tool for promoting economic development in the Guangdong-Hong Kong -Macao Greater Bay Area and along the Belt and Road. In alignment with the Government's policies, HKQAA launched the Green Finance Certification Scheme in 2018 and further expanded our efforts by introducing the Green and Sustainable Finance Certification Scheme in 2021. 


